The Interreg IV C project **CASA (Consortium for Assistive Solutions Adoption)** focuses on the development of regional policy and exchange of knowledge around the large scale implementation of innovative ICT solutions and services for independent living. 14 entities from 9 different countries interact and exchange experience on these topics during study visits, secondments, conferences.

The **Knowledge Transfer Conference in Timișoara** aims to showcase selected good practices from partner regions, find ways of supporting their integration into a new policy plan suited to local context and stimulate the development of ICT-based products/services and uptake of AAL solutions.

## Useful information



### Getting to the city from the airport

**According to possibilities and time of arrival, we will do our best to have everyone picked up from the airport. However, if this is not possible, please see the following alternatives. You will be contacted regarding your transfer, a few days prior to your arrival.**

Getting to the city centre by car takes aprox. 15-20 minutes, depending on traffic.

#### By taxi:

Taxis can be taken from the **right hand side of the airport as you exit the terminal for Domestic Flights**. There is a small sign for 2 taxi companies: **TUDO taxi** and **Fan taxi**. There might be drivers asking you if you need a taxi when you exit the airport, but please make sure you take one of these 2 companies indicated. The fare should be around 8-10 EUR. You can also pay in EUR, but please make sure you have small change as they might not have change to give you back. If there is no taxi belonging to these companies under the corresponding sign, you can call one and a car will be there in max. 10 min.

#### Transfer operated by hotel:

If you stay at Continental Hotel, you can have your transfer arranged directly with the hotel.

#### By bus:

There are [2 buses connecting the airport with the city centre](#), every hour:

**Express no.4 (E4)** – get off at last stop: BASTION;

**Express nr 4 (E4B)** – get off at BASTION (4th stop).

From the BASTION, there is a 5-10 min walk to each of the recommended hotels.

Tickets can be bought at the counter in Domestic Flights Terminal, the price is 2,5 lei (aprox 0,50 EUR).
